ONE: The name of this corporation is Fair Oaks Responsible Dog Owners Group, (herein after FORDOG).

TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes. The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are to support the off-leash canine recreational facilities (aka dog parks) within the community of Fair Oaks, California through fundraising and the education of the users of said dog parks.

On occasion, FORDOG may elect to undertake other activities of interest to the users of said dog parks, so long as such activities are directly related to canine behavior, recreation or safety.

 - (c) No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.
